



Rules for Amenity Use

All amenities are for use by current Remington Park residents only. A Remington Park Resident must accompany all guests. To protect our investment, we ask that all residents abide by these rules to ensure a safe and clean neighborhood. Please notify the Pool Maintenance Committee chairman of any problems concerning the pool area. Inform the Ground Maintenance Committee chairman if you notice any problems with all other amenities. In case of an emergency, there is an Emergency Call Station at the cabana gate or use your Cell Phone to dial 911.

Tennis Court

- All tennis players must be accompanied by a Remington Park resident who has signed in on the “sign-in” board and has photo identification on his / her person.
- Playing time limited to 1 hour (for singles or doubles) if persons are waiting to play.
- Appropriate tennis attire, including non-marking shoes, required at all times on the court.
- No more than four (4) players allowed on the court at any given time.
- No “court holding” allowed if all players are not present.
- Tennis courts are “first come – first served” basis.
- No paid instruction allowed on Remington Park courts.
- No smoking permitted on the court.
- No alcohol or glass bottles allowed on the court.
- No littering.
- No bicycles, skateboards, roller skates/blades, or wagons allowed on the court.
- No pets allowed on the court.
- Court hours are from sunrise to sunset.

Sport Court

- Limit play to one hour.
- Basketball shoes only. No black rubber-soled shoes.
- No smoking permitted on the court.
- No alcohol or glass bottles allowed on the court.
- No littering.
- No bicycles, skateboards, roller skates/blades, or wagons allowed on the court
- No pets allowed on the court.
- Court hours are from sunrise to sunset.

Swimming Pool

- Pool is open normally from May to October with opening and closing dates communicated in the newsletter
- Pool Hours are: 7:00 AM to 10:00 PM – use outside these hours is strictly prohibited.
- Residents are responsible for their children and guests complying with all rules governing the swimming pool area.
- A homeowner must accompany all guests in the pool area.
- Children under the age of 13 must be accompanied by an adult (age 18 or older) at all times.
- Wading pool is for children age six (6) and under and the handicapped only.
- No diving, running or horseplay allowed.
- No large flotation devices allowed in pool.
- No climbing on fence or entering the pool equipment area.
- No alcohol, glass bottles or containers permitted in the pool area.
- Homeowners are responsible for cleaning up their area after use. Please arrange chairs in a neat fashion when leaving the area.
- No bicycles, skateboards, rollerblades or wagons allowed in the pool area.
- No pets allowed in the pool area.
- Event Use:
 - Parties can be held in the cabana as long as a Remington Park homeowner is hosting the party.
 - The pool/cabana is not available for private parties and the cabana cannot be reserved, so if another homeowner comes to use the area or the pool they are allowed to do so.
 - There is no limitation on the number of outside guests but obviously you must keep it within reason.

Playground Equipment

- All children 8 years and younger must be accompanied by an adult (18 years or older) while in the playground area at all times.
- No smoking permitted in the playground area.
- No alcohol or glass bottles permitted in the playground area.
- No littering.
- No bicycles, skateboards or rollerblades allowed in the playground area.
- No pets allowed in the playground area.
- Playground hours are sunrise to sunset.

Park and Lake Areas

- Catch & release fishing only by Remington Park residents and accompanied guests.
- No swimming, boating, littering or loitering.
- No alcohol or firearms permitted.
- Pets must be kept on leashes and cleaned up after.

- Park hours are sunrise to sunset.

Jogging and Bicycle Paths

- No motorized vehicles allowed.
- No littering.
- Pets must be kept on leashes and cleaned up after.
- Path hours are sunrise to sunset.
