Special Leaf Collection

To continue from our leaf discussion, Special leaf and Christmas tree recycling collections will return this winter. Colleyville's trash and recycling provider will run special collection routes to recycle bagged leaves. This year's program's collection days are: **Saturday, Dec. 6, Dec. 13, Dec. 20, and Jan. 3** with collections beginning at 8:00 a.m. CWD will also collect and recycle Christmas trees on the January special collection day. Residents are asked to not enclose the tree in a plastic sack or bag and to remove all tinsel, stands and tree decorations. You just need to set out leaves on the designated collection days. CWD will recycle leaves contained in either a paper lawn craft bag or plastic bag. If leaf bags are set out prior to the Saturday collections, residents are asked to place leaf bags separately from household trash.
