Parking on the Street

On Friday night August 18, several cars in a nearby gated community were burglarized as reported to you in an email from our president Larry Owens. Leaving parked vehicles on the street overnight is a violation of the CC&Rs and there are good reasons for that provision. Parked vehicles can become involved in accidents by careless, distracted or impaired drivers, can be attractive for would be thieves prowling neighborhoods as well as causing traffic obstacles for drivers, bikers, runners and walkers. Keeping vehicles off our streets makes our neighborhood less attractive for criminals and more attractive overall. Please be vigilant and report any suspicious activities to the Colleyville police.

Another Reminder

All exterior repairs or improvements must be approved in advance of work beginning by the ARA. The website contains a link to the form and is easy to complete. You must be registered on the website as a resident to access the form. This includes repainting trim, reroofing, replacing gutters, windows and fences and any improvements. If in doubt, just submit a form; it's that easy!
